BABY STORYTIME

Baby Storytime for Ages 0 - 18 months

Thursdays from 2:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

June 22 through August 3

Support your baby's literacy through stories, songs, rhymes, and play. A parent or caregiver must attend with the child.

Limit 10 children.

TODDLER TIME

Toddler Time for Twos and Threes

Mondays from 10:30 a.m. to 10:50 a.m.

June 19 through July 31

Rhymes, stories, music, flannel boards, coloring, and bubbles! Child must be 2 by the starting date. A parent or caregiver must attend with the child.

Limit 10 children.

PRESCHOOL STORYTIME

Preschool Storytime for Ages 3 - 6

Tuesdays from 6:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

June 20 through August 1

Stories, music, flannel board stories, fingerplays, nursery rhymes, coloring, sign language, games and bubbles! Children must be 3 by the starting date.
